Dear Keith Wolahan,

I am directed by the Minister for Justice and Equality to acknowledge that you, Mr. Keith Wolahan, born, 30 September 1977, in Dublin, have made a declaration of alienage in the prescribed manner to relinquish your Irish Citizenship.

Under the provisions of Section 21 of the Irish Nationality and Citizenship Act 1956, as substituted by Section 7 of the 1986 Act, you will cease to be an Irish citizen upon the acquisition of another citizenship or if you already hold another citizenship, your Irish citizenship ceases with effect from 23 February 2015, the date of your declaration.
