Victorian DLP Senator John Madigan last month introduced a bill which would remove Medicare funding for such sex-selection abortions.

I do not believe our taxes should go to killing unborn babies simply because he or she is not the preferred gender.

Medicare funding should only go to genuine medical issues. Aborting a child because you are not happy with the gender is not a real medical issue. It is instead a lifestyle choice, and tax dollars should not go to such a case.

Where such practices exist, almost overwhelmingly, sex-selection abortions are done on females, not males. In terms of its sheer toll in human numbers, sex-selective abortion has assumed a scale tantamount to a global war against baby girls'."

This is treating children as a mere commodity, and it has no place in a civilised society.
