Answer:

Changes are frequently made to the Guide to Social Security Law to ensure it reflects current policy. Changes have been made to the Guide topic 6.7.1.45 Ten per cent Recovery Fee on Debts from False or Non-declaration of Income from Personal Exertion to reflect the introduction of the Employment Income Confirmation system (previously known as the Online Compliance Intervention), introduction of the interest charge on debts and recent enhancements to the Employment Income Confirmation system. This included amendments to the contact requirements and references to 'the decision maker' with the introduction of the automated system.
