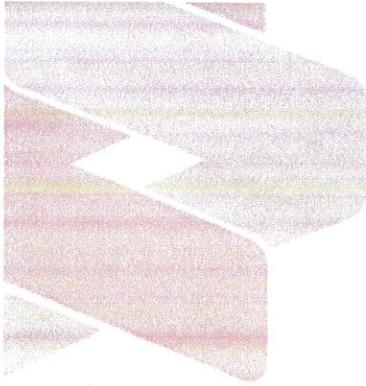
**Inquiry into the Rollout of the National Broadband Network**
