This is my submission on Senator Madigan's Bill to remove Medicare funding of gender selection abortions.

I believe aborting an unborn child solely on the basis of gender is not a medical procedure and should therefore not be afforded Medicare benefits. I further believe most Australians would not support their taxes being used for abortions based purely on cultural (some ethnic groups) and/or personal preferences (family balancing).
