RE: Submission for Health Insurance Amendment
(Medicare Funding for Certain Types of Abortion) Bill 2013.

I am writing in support of Senator John Madigan's Health Insurance Amendment (Medicare Funding for Certain Types of Abortion) Bill 2013 as it discriminates against the unborn child based on his or her gender.

Medicare funding should be removed when "the termination is carried out solely because of the gender of the foetus" section 17A (1) (b) as this can cause social consequences in the future such as sex trafficking, child abandonment, women viewed as an object ...
