APRA to appear before Economics Committee in Canberra

The Chairman and other Executive Members of the Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) will appear before the House Economics Committee on Friday, 28 November 2014 in Canberra. This is APRA's second appearance this year before the Committee.

Committee Chair Kelly O'Dwyer MP said: 'this hearing is a continuation of the committee's important discussions with APRA on the current policy settings and regulatory framework underpinning Australia's prudential standards'.

In addition to current and future prudential practices, the committee will be seeking updates from APRA on its nascent regulation of the superannuation industry and its continuing implementation of global prudential standards that have been agreed under the Basel III reforms.

Ms O'Dwyer stated: 'superannuation affects virtually all Australians and is a much more diverse sector than banking and insurance. The committee is looking forward to discussing APRA's progress in applying prudential standards to this highly complex industry. We are also keen to discuss how the application of global prudential standards will work for Australian financial institutions.'
