We strongly support the Health Insurance (Medicare Funding for Certain Types of Abortion)

Amendment Bill 2013. It is untenable that taxpayers fund the killing of certain babies on the basis of gender.

Any such funding is not the hallmark of a humane and compassionate society. There must be limits to self-interested choice at the expense of the innocent.

This is also a societal issue. Gender engineering is already having serious social consequences

for the populations of China and India.
