## Submission to Inquiry: Health Insurance Amendment (Medicare Funding for Certain Types of Abortion) Bill 2013. – by Mrs Mary Rofe RN

- **1.** The unacceptability to Australians of the use of Medicare funding for the purpose of gender selection abortions;
  - 1. Every Australian is entitled to the same treatment under the law.
  - 2. To use the law to discriminate against those of a particular gender is against this principle and is abhorrent to the Australian people
- **2.** The prevalence of gender selection with preference for a male child amongst some ethnic groups present in Australia and the recourse to Medicare funded abortions to terminate female children;
  - 3. Our culture should determine the focus of our laws.
  - 4. To adopt foreign principles and practices and legislate for their funding under Australian law is a betrayal of the Australian people and denies them their heritage of core values.
- **3.** The use of Medicare funded gender-selection abortions for the purpose of 'family-balancing';
  - 1. No government funding should be used for private purposes such as family balancing.
  - 2. Setting such a precedent would guarantee an endless call on the public purse for similar private purposes.
- **4.** Support for campaigns by United Nations agencies to end the discriminatory practice of gender-selection through implementing disincentives for gender-selection abortions';
  - 1. Australia's leadership in outlawing these abuses of government funding will set a standard for other nations.
- **5.** Concern from medical associations in first world countries about the practice of gender-selection abortion, viz. Canada, USA, UK.
  - 1. Australia should be proud of its heritage of protecting life and a fair go for all and more than that, Australia should

- give support and encouragement to like-minded professionals across the globe who fight to save lives.
- 2. As a Registered Nurse of over 40yrs standing I understand the pressures that bad legislation such as this could place on medical professionals who cherish a high regard for their oath to protect and defend life.
- 3. Australia must lead the way in protection and upholding of Australian mores and values free of the pressures from value systems in other cultures.
