Client Snapshot

As of 1 December 2011, SIDC has 217 clients. This comprises 52 Afghani clients, 154 Tamil clients and 11 Rohingya clients. Of these, 77 clients (35.4%) are on a probable positive pathway (1A Met); 11 clients are 1A met with adverse security (5.1%) and the remainder, 171, are on a probable removal pathway (59.5%). The average length of detention is 506 days.

There are 58 clients awaiting an IMR hearing and the average waiting time is 187 days while 29 clients are awaiting an IMR outcome and the average waiting time is 137 days. All cases have been escalated. There are 61 clients awaiting judicial review. There have been 15 judicial review outcomes: the department has withdrawn from nine cases and these clients are awaiting a further IMR; five clients have lost their appeal and one client has been successful at judicial review.
