Inquiry into Australia Council Bill 2013 and related Bill

The Australian Copyright Council (ACC) is an independent, not-for-profit organisation, founded in 1968. The ACC has 24 member organisations. These include the peak bodies for Australian creators as well as the major collecting societies. This represents over a million writers, musicians, visual artists, designers, photographers, directors, performers, choreographers, producers, publishers, record labels and architects working in Australian creative industries.

The ACC has three key functions: information, advice and advocacy on copyright law and practice for Australian creators and the broader community.

The ACC has a longstanding relationship with the Australia Council for the Arts, having been one of the original recipients of Australia Council funding. The ACC continues to receive a significant part of its funding from the Australia Council.

The ACC participated in the Government's consultation process in developing the National Cultural Policy: *Creative Australia* and in the Review of the Australia Council. The ACC supports the Australia Council Bill 2013 and the Australia Council (Consequential and Transitional Provisions) Bill 2013.
