

Ref: Sex Discrimination Amendment (Sexual Orientation, Gender Identity and Intersex Status) Bill 2013

Dear Committee

1. This Bill adds discrimination attributes of sexual orientation, gender identity and intersex as “protected grounds.” I agree with the view proposed by Family Voice Australia that “Passing such a bill would further cement same-sex rights and could be used as a lever to destabilise marriage laws.”
