QUESTION:

ACTING CHAIR: I am wondering how that translates to employment. That is an unbelievable turnaround in 15 years. How has employment changed in that 15-year period? I know we are down to about 44,000 or something in the PMV sector. What was it 15 years ago, do you know?

AMIF / MTAA RESPONSE

Employment in the manufacturing sector of the auto industry in Australia peaked in 1973 at 100,000 persons. Since then the rate of production of vehicles and the number of employees has fluctuated from time to time but for most of the time has been on a steady decline to the point where in 2012 it was 50,000 persons.

The peak of Australian production of Personal Motor Vehicles (PMVs) occurred in 1987 when 86% of PMVs sold were manufactured in Australia. When light trucks and SUVs are included the Australian produced percentage reduces to 73% in 1987.

1987 was 28 years ago and before many Government auto industry reforms were introduced.

As a result of The Button Plan, automotive tariffs and quotas were reduced over time. By 1988 import tariffs had been reduced form 57.5% to 45% and quotas had been removed. The reduction in tariffs has continued ever since. Government policies are obviously one of the reasons for the change in employment. International market conditions are also an important contributor to change. The Australian new vehicle market is now fully integrated into the global market. It was not 15 plus years ago.

15 years ago in 1999 PMV imports were 286,000 out of a total of 547,000 vehicles sold or 52% and total auto manufacturing employment was 51,000 persons of which 17,000 were directly involved in Motor Vehicle Manufacturing.

By 2013 that number of imported PMVs had increased to 472,775 or 83% of PMV sales. Total employment was 50,000 of which 17,000 were in motor vehicle manufacturing.

Employment in motor vehicle manufacturing plants increased during the years 2000 to 2006 peaking at 27,000 persons but fell again to 17,000 in 2012. Keep in mind that in 1999 there were more participants and more plants operating building a greater range of models. In 2015 there are three plants and three models.

	 Australian vehicle manufacturers struggled to match consumer demand for smaller vehicles and competition from overseas is intense. Australia is one of the most open and attractive right hand drive markets in the world for automotive imports. One of the most powerful forces in reduction of Australian PMV manufacture is the global nature of the automotive manufacturing industry and oversupply of vehicles worldwide, which may be readily moved and sold in countries like Australia, that have embraced free trade. Barriers to entry are now almost non -existent and international trade in new vehicles is buoyant.
	Australia has become a popular destination for automotive goods manufactured in a wide range of countries. This outcome was made possible because of the diversification of global car market which is now very competitive. New entrants from China, India, Malaysia and others are seeking markets for their rapidly developing auto manufacturing capacities.
	Over the last ten years some older and very well developed auto manufacturers have re-entered the Australian market importing vehicles with success displacing Australian made products i.e.: Volkswagen, Jeep and Chrysler.

still be an engineering focus for manufacturing in this country. That was evidenced by two wholly Australian designed cars featuring at the Detroit motor show earlier this year. We also believe that in the spirit of the massive transformation that is occurring across the entire industry if the ATS were to be recalibrated issues such as training and skills development across the broader automotive industry and some of those areas should be looked at as part of that.

QUESTION:

Senator KIM CARR: Perhaps you want to take this on notice, because we have to prepare an interim report to the Senate on your suggestions about how the automotive transformation scheme, in your view, should be amended to facilitate the transition to a new automotive industry in this country. I take your point that your submission says that the automotive industry should be more broadly defined, and that traditionally we have spoken about the automotive industry as if it was only the firms registered on the ATS. Your view is that the industry is much bigger and includes many more people. In fact, you claim that 75 per cent of the industry is represented outside of the ATS. Is that the proposition you are putting? *Mr Dudley: That is the proposition.*

Senator KIM CARR: It is an important question to get to the bottom of. We can be precise about the number of firms that are registered under ATS. I do not know what the number is at the moment; it is 126 individual companies, or something of that type. It is said, on the basis of what we understand of how the industry operates, there are probably 1,000 companies associated with those companies, who supply them—tiers 2, 3, 4 and so on in the supply chain. Would you agree with that analysis?

Mr Dudley: I suggest that that is what we have heard as well, and what we— Senator KIM CARR: But you do not represent any of those firms—the 2-, 3-, 4- and 5-tier firms.

QUESTION/ON NOTICE

Mr Dudley: I would have to take on notice as to whether they are. They could well be one of my members. I just do not have that information.

Automotive industry production and trade

This section looks at production of vehicles and their components in Australia, but does not extend to production of caravans, trailers and commercial vehicle body building.

As so often occurs there is much discontinuity in the data, which inhibits long term comparisons. However we have constructed a comprehensive vehicle production series for the 2nd half of the 20th century and up to 2013, which allows tracking of trends since 1950. This series is shown in the chart below and tabulated on page 69.

The chart shows:

- strong growth in Australian vehicle production from the 1950s, to a peak in the mid 1970s
- with a more open market plus policy encouraging rationalisation and specialisation by the Australian vehicle industry, a long decline to the early 1990s
- broadly some recovery to the late 2000s, particularly linked to export growth, although production slumped in 2009 with the weak local market for large cars and the impact of the GFC on export markets and has remained low since.


Volume data tends to understate the significance of the growth over the 1990s and most of the 2000s; rationalisation of the local industry removed lower value added vehicles - lower local content models and small cars - while exports added to production of higher value large cars. Holden partly reversed that trend in 2010 as it began assembly of the small PMV segment Cruze.

It is more difficult to measure the growth of the automotive component sector and of employment, because the available data is limited and some has significant discontinuities, but:

- the value of component production was rising up to mid last decade but fell back in the 2nd half of the decade and especially with the impact of the GFC
- although industry employment has been on a long decline, the strong growth in vehicle production
 up to the mid 2000s also temporarily reversed that trend, but it has fallen back since.

Automotive industry production and employment

It is difficult to get continuous and up to date, long term value of production and employment data for most industries, including the automotive industry. The data in the chart below and the table over the page is from 5 principal Australian Bureau of Statistics series.

The major breaks in consistency in the series occur:

- between 1968 and 1969 earlier definitions included within the motor bodies etc classification much of what was later included in motor vehicle manufacturing
- from 2000 to 2001 the basis of the data changed from "manufacturing establishments" to "management units". This change added separate head offices, parts distribution etc, to the data and thus large increases for most of the 2001 data. "Sales and service income" also replaced turnover as the aggregate measure of activity
- in 2002 there were again changes in methodology, which would have raised sales and service income by about 5 percent in 2001 for both total manufacturing and for machinery and equipment manufacturing - of the latter, motor vehicle manufacturing represented more than half
- from 2007-08 to 2009-10, ABS released experimental data from modeling of ABS survey data and Australian Taxation Office Business Activity Statement data and similar methodology has been used for subsequent data.

The changes are many and substantial, including recently, and it is not practical to detail them. Data should therefore be treated as broad indicators of the change in industry size. To allow a more valid comparison we have adjusted employment data in the chart below. 2001 has been scaled down using preceding ANZSIC data, while employment data for 2007-08 for the chart has been estimated using 2006-07 and 2008-09 employment as well as wage and salary data.

The data for ANZIC 231 used here does not include all production and employment which may be considered part of the automotive industry - for instance tyre and rubber component making is in the ANZSIC polymer product class.


Ignoring the jolt in 1968-69, the employment data for automotive industry manufacturing broadly shows:

- a rise from the late 1940s until the mid 1970s
- a long term decline from the mid 1970s
- · relative stability through the 1990s after a sharp fall early
- generally higher employment during the last decade
- a slump in 2008-09 which has essentially continued up to 2011-12.

Cyclical variations are similar to vehicle sales although, in the 1990s, industry rationalisation tended to offset the recovery in domestic sales and increased exports.

Data on the value of output and turnover - as given in the table - is somewhat less enlightening over such a long period as inflation alone has multiplied monetary values many times.

Employment in motor bodies etc rose strongly last decade partly because of caravans, but probably mostly because of bus bodies and larger articulated trucks and trailers.



The sources of the data in the chart and in the table at right are Australian Bureau of Statistics, *Manufacturing Industries, Australia* annual bulletins for Motor Vehicles and Cycles from 1949-50 to 1967-68 and is based on the Factory Classification (1945). Subsequent data is from ABS, *Manufacturing Industry*, cat. 8221.0 and *Experimental Estimates for the Manufacturing Industry*, cat. 8159.0, with 1969 to 1992 data from Industry Commission, *Manufacturing Industry Data, 1995*. Notes are continued below the table at right. 2001 and 2008 data has been adjusted and estimated respectively by AAI.

The table on the left like the chart on page 67 provides data on the Australian production of CBU vehicles, illustrating:

- the rapid growth in production through the 1950s and 1960s
- the decline from the mid 1970s to early 1990s
- a relatively strong revival after the mid 1990s
- the slump in production in 2009 as both domestic and export markets contracted, a degree of recovery in 2010 and falling back since.

Underlying these patterns have been some other trends:

- until the mid 1960s, typically up to a third of vehicles made in Australia were assembled from imported panels and this type of assembly largely disappeared during the 1970s
- production then concentrated on larger cars and subsequent growth largely came from exports, but with some major fluctuations
- except with the continuing Holden Commodore and Ford Falcon derivatives and Ford Territory, SUV and light commercial output was mostly assembly with low local content.

Production fell back quite markedly in 2006, after increasing strongly between 2002 and 2004, in the latter year to the highest level since 1979 both for estimated production of total vehicles as well as for light vehicles.

The weaker production in 2007 and 2008 was mostly the result of the domestic market for the locally made large cars contracting, after substantial rises in fuel prices and poor residual values for those cars in the used car market, as export production was approaching and then setting records in those years.

However the collapse of Holden export markets combined with the falling local sales of large cars in the last 5 years to reduce production markedly.

Given that low local content assembly had largely disappeared, large cars, light commercials and SUVs replaced many low valued cars in local production, the gains in the first half of the last decade are more impressive - the relatively small number of locally built heavy buses and trucks plus the 2011 commencement of Holden Cruze assembly are the exceptions.

Most of the data in the table at left to 2000 is based on ABS data and therefore differs to some degree from the totals of light vehicles shown in the table on the next page, which has been collated from other sources. The differences are relatively small in any one year and appear to arise from slightly different definitions and timing.

The data in this table has been compiled from:

- 1950 to 1962 ABS, Manufacturing Industries, Australia, construction and assembly of motor bodies, excluding truck cabins; years ended June
- 1962 to 2000 ABS, Manufacturing Production, Australia, cat 8363.0 and subsequent spreadsheet data; calendar years
- LCV and SUV data from 1962 to 1965 has been estimated from motor body construction and assembly data and heavy truck figures are the remainder of total vehicles for goods and materials
- LCV and SUV production from 1985 and HCV production from 1997 has been estimated by AAI from sales - HCV from 1985 to 1996 are residuals. The total from 1997 to 2001 includes these AAI estimates. 2001 to 2013 data is estimated from sales, *Australasian Bus and Coach* data, production data in Department of Industry, *Key Automotive Statistics* and data provided by the vehicle manufacturers. Estimates are rounded.

Some revision of earlier data can occur from year to year. 2013 data is preliminary.

The data is from Industry Commission, *The Automotive Industry, 1997* and Department of Industry, Innovation, Science, Research and Tertiary Education, *Key Automotive Statistics (KAS)*, 1999 to 2012, except as below. Derivatives include utes, vans, and long wheel based variants such as Holden Caprice.

2013 data is based on data from Toyota and Ford, with model figures for Holden estimated from sales data and FCAI total production and rounded - the sum of the models therefore differs slightly from the FCAI total for 2013 of 210,538. DIISR figures have traditionally differed slightly from the FCAI data and that collected from the companies and/or estimated by AAI.

Comparison of production figures from these sources with sales data suggested that certain published figures were inaccurate, notably the Holden Commodore figure for 1985 to 1993, the "other" figure for 1985 and Ford Falcon production for 1996. These figures have been revised using data supplied by the companies. Except for 1985 and 1996 the total figure has not been amended. The "other" figure is therefore a residual to 1993, and is affected by our changes to Commodore data, and should represent the volumes for vehicles removed from production prior to 1995. Amended data is shown in red.

Mitsubishi Magna data includes preceding Mitsubishi Sigma and Toyota Camry includes preceding Corona, series for which have been supplied by the companies. Holden Vectra was assembled in Australia 1998 to 2000, while Holden Cruze assembly commenced in late 2010.


It is not clear whether all early data includes CKD production - Commodore data includes CKDs, as does Toyota Camry and other data after 1993. Ford Falcon exports to mid 1991 were largely CKD but these may not be included. Some CKD may be missing from the total prior to 1993.

The chart opposite shows production of light vehicles by model, key features being:

- Holden Commodore line rising strongly to 2004, then falling with domestic sales and the loss of Pontiac exports
- Toyota Camry and Aurion production rising strongly to 2007, primarily for export, but lower in recent years
- Mitsubishi Magna/380 in decline before end of production in 2008
- Ford Falcon fluctuating then falling markedly since 2004; Territory fell back after a strong start but has partly recovered with its upgrades.

Production fell markedly in 2009, after record exports and has remained low.






