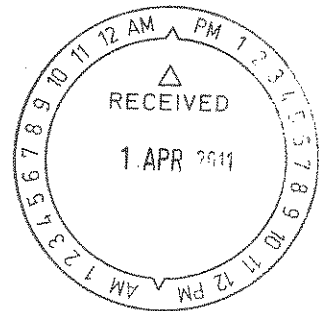

Not my mother, just nurses coming & going, because my mother wasn't permitted to see me. My mother was given a period of time to come & get me, of which she did, after finding a suitable place to live. But I was transferred to another

hospital, hidden. And my mother was told to go & get along with her life. Which she did, twenty six years later when we were re-united.

To strip a mother of her baby, is a cruel cruel act. But to leave a baby alone is another.

And that's how i am, alone. feeling as if i do not have the capacity to love, because, it took me a long time to learn it.

Nobody checked on my mother, & nobody checked on me. Somebody made the decision to separate us, but nobody cared for our welfare.
