



## Indigenous alcohol inquiry continues in Sydney

The House of Representatives Standing Committee on Indigenous Affairs will be holding a public hearing in Sydney on Friday 5 September 2014, as it continues to collect evidence for the inquiry into the harmful use of alcohol in Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

The Committee will hear from a number of eminent witnesses about the harmful use of alcohol as a health issue. Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD) will be a focus of the hearing, with diagnosis, prevention, education and support being key areas of inquiry for the Committee.

The Committee Chair, Member for Murray, Dr Sharman Stone MP, said “The Committee also continues to receive evidence on the relationship between the harmful use of alcohol and the overrepresentation of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people in the criminal justice system.”

“The lack of recognition of FASD has far-reaching consequences for those with FASD and their families. We know that people with FASD are more likely to end up in juvenile detention and prison, rather than receiving the early intervention and support they need.”

“The Committee needs to document best practice from experts in the areas of health and the law so we can better respond to these issues.”
