Information about this form

This form is for non-citizens seeking Refugee Determination in Papua New Guinea pursuant to Section 14 of the Migration Regulation 1979 (the Regulation). For the purpose of Section 15A of the Migration Act 1978, Section 14(1) of the Regulation, provides that a non-citizen may be determined to be a refugee if the Minister is satisfied that -

- (a) The non-citizen has been transferred to Papua New Guinea under the Memorandum of Understanding between the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and the Government of Australia, Relating to the Transfer to and Assessment of Persons in Papua New Guinea and Related to Issues; and
- (b) The non-citizen holds a well-founded fear of being persecuted for reasons of race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group or political opinion; and
- (c) The non-citizen
 - (i) Is outside of the country of his or her nationality and is unable or owing to such fear, is unwilling to avail himself of herself of the protection of that country; or
 - (ii) Does not have a nationality and being outside his or her country of former habitual residence is unable, or, owing to sure fear, is unwilling to return to it.
- (d) The non-citizen is not excluded from recognition as a refugee in Papua New Guinea under subsection (2).

Under Section 14(2) of the Regulation, a non-citizen will be excluded from recognition if the Minister is satisfied that the non-citizen -

- (a) Has been recognised by the competent authorities of a country in which he or she has taken residence or held residence as having the rights and obligations which are attached to possession of the nationality of that country; or
- (b) Has committed a crime against peace, a war crime, or a crime against humanity, as defined in the international instruments drawn up to make provision in respect of such crimes; or
- (c) Has committed a serious non-political crime in another country; or
- (d) Has been found guilty of acts contrary to the purpose and principles of the United Nations; or
- (e) Is a threat to the national security or defence of Papua New Guinea if he or she remains in Papua New Guinea; or
- (f) Is a member of, or adheres to, any organisation or group of persons that has engaged in, or has claimed responsibility for, a terrorist act in or outside Papua New Guinea and the continued presence of that person in Papua New Guinea constitutes a threat to public safety; or
- (g) Has engaged in, or has claimed responsibility for, a terrorist act in or outside Papua New Guinea and the continued presence of that person in Papua New Guinea constitutes a threat to public safety; or
- (h) Has, during the period of his or her residency at the regional processing centre anywhere or within Papua New Guinea,

WARNING: The Migration Act 1978 lays down penalties for persons who deliver or otherwise furnish for official purposes of the government, documents containing information or statements that are false or misleading.

- 2. I acknowledge that either:
 - a. a representative from Playfair has explained the contents of the documents titled "Transferee information leaflet" and "Instructions" to me with the assistance of an interpreter, or
 - b. if I decide not to use an interpreter, I have understood this leaflet.
- 3. Playfair may cease assisting me if I:
 - a. provide false information to a representative of Playfair;
 - b. fail to provide instructions to Playfair within a reasonable period;
 - c. fail to accept advice given by Playfair;
 - d. engage another representative to provide me with advice or assistance;
 - e. do anything that results in Playfair having a conflict of interest; or
 - f. otherwise indicate that Playfair do not have my confidence

After that Playfair will not provide me with any further assistance.

- 4. I can ask Playfair to stop helping me at any time and if I do Playfair will not provide me with any further assistance.
- 5. I understand that if Playfair ceases to assist me or I ask them to stop helping me I will be completely responsible for my application and it will be up to me to prove that I am entitled to protection.
