I wish to make a submission to the Senate Finance and Public Administration Committee regarding the above Bill, and to add my support for this Bill.

I am horrified to hear that Medicare is being used to fund abortions in Australia due to the foetus being "the wrong sex", ie in most case, the female sex. Such selective abortions, whether the reason is cultural, personal preferences in "family planning" (ie too many female babies born into a family), etc are repulsive to any person who believes that female children are as valuable as male children.

For Medicare to fund gender-specific abortions is to discriminate against a female foetus, and I feel that our Government should be supporting the United Nations campaign to halt deliberate gender-specific abortions by ceasing the Medicare support for these abortions.
