Please, note that we are potentially affected residents of the Stockyard Hill Wind farm which is situated 2km from our home and within 1.5km of our work place, our farm. We need further investigations in to what causes health problems of people living close to wind farms. The excessive noise emitted by the wind farms could affect us, our children and the community of Chepstowe-Mt Emu. We also need to know what impact the turbines could have on property values especially our lifestyles property. Will they also have an impact on our farm income as we run a Japanese-Australian farm-stay business (Due to viewing red flashing lights when looking at the stars in the night sky)? Will the turbines decrease the overall property sales if located next door within the 3km range? It isn't fair that a multi million dollar windturbine company Origin will not buy us out. We have a small free range egg farm and the turbines could have devastating effects on our egg production. I already suffer with migraines and do not want my children to have any health effects due to the windturbines. The Government must address this situation to stop further problems from happening in the future.
