## 02 Registration Date

The competition is open to Australian primary schools and commences on Wednesday, 20 February 2008. Schools must register for the competition by Friday, 28 March 2008. The competition will close at 5.00pm on Wednesday, 30 April 2008. All posters must be received by the closing date.

## 03 How to Enter

To enter the competition, follow the instructions for the poster competition that are provided on our competition flyer. Schools are responsible for the cost of sending posters to Parliament House.

## 04 Judging Criteria

The competition will be judged by a panel from the Department of the House of Representatives which will decide the best entry by considering:

- ▶ how original your entry is;
- ▶ how interesting and creative your entry is; and
- ▶ how much impact your entry has.

## 05 Judges' Decision is Final

The judging panel alone will decide the entry that best meets the judging criteria. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

## 06 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded as follows:

**First place:** \$2000  
**Second place:** \$1000  
**Third place:** \$500

## 07 No Cost to Enter

Entry into our competition is free.

## 08 Eligibility

Only Australian primary schools can enter and win our competition.

## 09 Date and Time of Judging

Judging will take place on the morning of 7 May 2008.

## 10 Location of judging

Judging will take place at Parliament House, Canberra ACT 2600.

## 11 Notifications and Publication of Winners

Winners will be contacted by phone and email within seven working days after the judging date.

## 12 Entries become Our Property
