Further to Claire Young's email attached, please find attached, files providing data on Indigenous enrolments and Indigenous students as requested by the Committee. The data can be based on either the number of students or enrolments which explains the discrepancy between to the two data sets. Student data is based on a student head count, while enrolment data is the number of course enrolments, and included individual students with multiple course enrolments.

Indigenous student enrolments in Publicly Funded - TAFE by jurisdiction

As requested data in Table 2 (attached) has been provided for national comparisons of Indigenous student **enrolments** by jurisdictions.

For national comparisons, data is sourced from the NCVER VOCSTATS. Due to slightly different business counting rules applied nationally this data will not exactly match the TAFE NSW data (first dot point above) but is comparable. (attached in Table 2 – extract below).

This data by Reporting Type for 2010 indicates that for Publicly funded - TAFE, apart from Northern Territory, NSW had the highest share of Indigenous student enrolments as a percentage of total enrolments (6.4%)
