Climate change in the Top End

The House Committee on Climate Change, Environment and the Arts is visiting the Northern Territory as part of its inquiry into Australia's biodiversity in a changing climate. During its visit, Committee members will learn more about how future climate change is expected to affect the Top End's iconic plants, animals and ecosystems, especially in Kakadu National Park.

The Committee will receive briefings on a range of issues from park managers and representatives from local Indigenous communities. Members will hear about issues as diverse as sea level rise, increasingly severe weather events, changes in rainfall and fire patterns, and saltwater intrusion into Kakadu's precious wetlands.

The Committee will also hold a public hearing in Darwin on Wednesday, where it expects to hear evidence on the effects that climate change across the Territory, and how government and non-government groups are taking steps to protect the local biodiversity.

The Committee Chair, Mr Tony Zappia MP, said "Several submissions to the inquiry have nominated the wetlands of Kakadu National Park as a nationally important ecosystem. The Committee welcomes the opportunity to use Kakadu as a case study as part of its inquiry into the effects of climate change on Australia's biodiversity."

Mr Zappia added, "As one of the few sites to be listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Area for both its natural and cultural values, the Committee is certainly very interested to hear how climate change might shape Kakadu in the coming years, and what strategies might be used to protect the local biodiversity."
