Review of the Special Broadcasting Service Annual Report 2002-2003 — Appearance by VCA before the Committee

I refer to the VCA's Submission, by way of letters dated 9th and 10th February, sent to the Committee prior to its 11th February Review hearing at which the matter of Thoi Su in SBS Television's WorldWatch was a major item.

As you may recall, we have made suggestions and observations relating to:

- The parameters that should govern how SBS Television consults with its kev stakeholders
- The key features of a SBS complaints handling process which is effective and independent, and seen as such (on this, we have made a submission to SBS itself, in response to its public call for submissions)
- With respect to a Vietnamese-language news program for WorldWatch, our views on how that may be achieved

As the 11 February hearing has not resolved those issues, we ask you to further pursue them in the next hearing of your Committee and keep us informed of the oucome.
