## House Economics Committee to hold Roundtable with Tourism Industry in Brisbane

The House of Representatives Economics Committee will hold a roundtable hearing with key players in the tourism industry tomorrow. Roundtable participants will include, among others, Tourism Australia, the Queensland Tourism Industry Council and Gold Coast Tourism.

The roundtable forms part of the committee's inquiry into the current and future directions of Australia's service industries. This inquiry, which was referred by Treasurer Peter Costello, has received more than 40 submissions to date. The committee also held a tourism roundtable in Sydney last week.

Committee Chair, Bruce Baird, today said 'the Tourism sector is a key contributor to Australia's economy; it is the dominant service industry and, along side coal and iron ore, is one of Australia's biggest exports'.

'This roundtable will provide an excellent opportunity for the committee and the industry to consider some of the issues and challenges, but also to explore future growth opportunities' Mr Baird said.
