#### **Surplus Transfer Value**

Weighted Surplus Transfer Value Calculation

#### **Distribution of Preferences – Reiterative Count**

Principle: "Votes for excluded candidate should be redistributed as if the excluded candidate had not stood" - Wright System

#### **Droop Quota**

Droop Quota should be scrapped in favour if a pure proportional representation (x/y)

## **Group Voting**

Group votes to be distributed equally to all candidates within a group. Order of Group Candidates exclusion to be in reverse order of the group candidates.

# **Scrutiny of Electronic Count**

Scrutineers MUST be provided copies of the electronic data-entry file during the count. This should be published on line and in real time as the data-entry progresses. Without access to this data it is impossible t properly scrutinise an electronic count.

### **Candidate Deposits and Refunds**

Candidates Deposits should be increased to \$5000 per candidate with refunds only paid on the basis of one refund per 4% of the vote

# **Optional Preferential Voting**

MUST not be available for Group Ticket voting

Statement on ballot paper: In order to maximise your vote you should indicate a preference for EVERY candidate in order of your choice Minimum 6 (12) preferences
