Indigenous Law and Justice Inquiry to Hold Public Hearing in Perth

Federal Parliament's Public Accounts and Audit Committee will continue its inquiry into the provision of legal aid services to Indigenous Australians with a public hearing tomorrow afternoon in Perth.

Chair of the Committee, Mr Bob Baldwin MP, stated: "The Perth hearing will bring to a close two days of travel across Australia to gather evidence from providers and clients of legal services to Indigenous Australians. Over the last two days the Committee has taken evidence regarding the provision of legal services in regional New South Wales, a remote area community in the Northern Territory and will close with a metropolitan area of Western Australia."

"The evidence from this program of public hearings will be considered together with evidence taken at public hearings in Canberra, Sydney, Darwin, Alice Springs and Adelaide during the last Parliament as well as written submissions received by the Committee."

"In Perth the Committee will hear from the Aboriginal Legal Service and the Legal Aid Commission and will be interested in their views of the tendering out of Aboriginal Legal and Torres Strait Islander Legal Services which is drawing to a close in the State."
