## WATCHING BRIEF ON THE WAR ON TERRORISM PUBLIC HEARING

The third in a series of public hearings on Australia's preparedness to manage and respond to the consequences of a terrorist attack in Australia will be held in Darwin on Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> of July, 2003

The hearing is being conducted by the Joint Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, Defence and Trade as part of the Committee's ongoing Watching Brief on Australia's involvement in the War on Terrorism and into related actions in response to terrorism.

The hearing on Thursday, 17<sup>th</sup> of July will focus on the role of the Northern Territory Government agencies in coordinating the immediate response to, and managing the consequences of, a terrorist attack.
