## NORTHERN AUSTRALIA DEVELOPMENT ENQUIRY

I am writing in reference to the Joint Select Committee on Northern Australia's Inquiry into the Development of Northern Australia.

In late 2013. MMG made a submission to the Coalition's 2030 Vision for Developing Northern Australia (referred to as "the paper" hereafter). In our submission, we reinforced our belief in the tremendous potential, under the right policy settings, for Northern Australia to fuel and sustain national growth.
