Review of Agreement on the exchange of Tax information with Bermuda

The Joint Standing Committee on Treaties, chaired by Dr Andrew Southcott MP, will hold a public hearing on Monday 27 February to examine an Agreement with the Government of Bermuda on the exchange of tax information.

Under the auspices of the OECD's Global Forum on Taxation, the Agreement aims to improve transparency and establish the effective exchange of tax information with Bermuda. In addition, the Agreement is designed to inhibit the use of tax havens and safeguard the interests of taxpayers through enhanced economic cooperation between Australia and Bermuda.

"This Agreement is a first for Australia and could create the impetus for similar agreements with low tax regime countries to discourage tax evasion and improve the integrity of the Australian Tax System. The Committee will review the Treaty and consider whether it should be ratified," Dr Southcott said.

The Committee will also hear evidence in relation to six other treaties, listed in the hearing program below.

The public hearing will be held in **Committee Room 2R1**, **Parliament House**, **Canberra** on **Monday**, **27 February 2006** from **10.00 am**.
