I wish to comment on the proposed Bankruptcy Legislation Amendment (Anti-Avoidance and Other Measures) Bill 2004.

Whilst I do not condone, under any circumstances, persons intentionally avoiding the payment of their debts, I believe that the retrospectivity of the proposed legislation, in particular, unfairly (potentially) penalises those persons who have legitimately and prudently arranged their financial affairs in a legal and appropriate manner.
