INQUIRY INTO IMMIGRATION BRIDGE

I am strongly opposed to this nuisance being placed upon the lake, impeding its use by yachts and degrading the view for those walking by the lake.

The process adopted by Immigration Bridge Australia (IBA) to settle the design for the Immigration Bridge (the Bridge) has taken no account of the views of users of the lake. Nor has it sought to take into account the views of a majority of those descended from immigrants such as myself. Who appointed these people to wreck our lake's amenity? Or did they appoint themselves?
