Draws to the attention of the House:

The continual catastrophic consequences victims suffer as a result of school and workplace bullying with no laws to successfully protect victims against such behavior and no laws to successfully prosecute perpetrators or corporations who allow victims to continually suffer at the hands of their bullies with the most common outcome of the victim to not only suffer psychological damage and even suicide, but always it is the victim who is removed from their classroom or place of work whether it be a managerial, medical or personal reason, leaving behind their friends and familiarity whilst their perpetrators are allowed to continue successfully in their place of choice with little if any consequences.
