

PROPOSED FIT-OUT OF NEW LEASED PREMISES FOR THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL'S DEPARTMENT AT 3-5 NATIONAL CIRCUIT, BARTON, ACT

I refer to your letter dated 2 July 2004 regarding the above proposal which is being considered by the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Public Works.

The site of the proposed works is within the Central National Area which is a Designated Area as defined in the National Capital Plan (the Plan). Consequently, all 'works' proposed on the site requires prior approval in writing from the National Capital Authority pursuant to section 12.(1)(b) of the Australian Capital Territory (Planning and Land Management) Act 1988 (the Act).

The Act defines 'works' to include:

- (a) the construction, alteration, extension or demolition of buildings or structures;
- (b) landscaping;
- (c) tree-felling; or
- (d) excavations;

but excludes anything done inside buildings or structures.

The Authority is yet to consider the new office development proposal for the site for Works Approval. However, the fit-out works which are subject of the Committee's inquiry are all 'inside the building' and therefore do not require any approval from the Authority.
