

On reviewing our current submissions to the Committee, we have discovered an error in that part of our submission which covers the Bragg Institute Offices and Laboratory Proposed Extension. The error relates to the description of the proposal. Sections 2.2 and 2.3 should read as follows:

2.2 Design Objectives and General Design Principles

Design will be to Australian Standards and the BCA (Building Code of Australia), thereby delivering a reliable and maintainable facility. ANSTO standards will also apply where practical.

The design of the facility will be in accordance with best practice for laboratories and office accommodation and will achieve a minimum 4.5 star ABGR/NABER rating.

2.3 Scope of Works

The facility is to be a purpose-built world class office facility and laboratory to accommodate the Bragg Institute staff, including the National Deuteration Facility, under one roof and in close proximity to existing Bragg Institute infrastructure at the OPAL reactor.

Preliminary planning has indicated a floor space requirement of approximately 3,250 square metres for the facility extension.
