On 19 July 2010, the Parliament was prorogued. A General Election was held on 21 August 2010. The 42<sup>nd</sup> Parliament finished on 27 September 2010 and the 43<sup>rd</sup> Parliament commenced on the following day.

This report is divided into several sections that provide statistics on committee work during the following periods:

- the half year (1 July 2010 to 31 December 2010); and
- the year (1 January 2010 to 31 December 2010)
- the end of the 42nd Parliament (1 July 2010 to 27 September 2010), and
- the commencement of the 43<sup>rd</sup> Parliament (28 September 2010 to 31 December 2010)
