Senator Carr asked in writing:

- (a) How many employees were employed on fixed-term contracts, in each year of the previous 6 years?
- (b) What percentage of the total number of employees is this for each of these years?
- (c) What was the percentage of total employees for contract employees, for each year of the previous 6 years?
- (d) How many employees were employed on fixed term contracts at each classification level, for each year of the past six years?
- (e) How many employees on a fixed term contract, for each year of the past six years, have been employed more than once on a fixed term contract? Please provide details of position classification in each instance?

Answer:

Employees on fixed-term contracts are included as non-ongoing employees, see Question W306-04. Not all non-ongoing employees would be on fixed-term contracts. Data is not available on the number of employees on fixed-term contracts.
