 2. ALTERATION OF DAY OF NEXT MEETING.—Mr. Fenton (Acting Prime Minister) moved, That the House, at its rising, adjourn until Wednesday next at three o'clock p.m.
Question—put and passed.
 3. IRON AND STEEL PRODUCTS BOUNTY BILL (1930).—The Order of the Day having been read for the third reading—Mr. Forde (Honorary Minister) moved, That the Bill be now read a third time.
Debate ensued.
Question—put and passed.—Bill read a third time.
 4. NORTHERN TERRITORY (ADMINISTRATION) BILL (1930).—The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question, That the Bill be now read a second time—
Debate resumed.
Mr. Killen moved, That the debate be now adjourned.
Question—That the debate be now adjourned—put and passed.
Ordered—That the resumption of the debate be made an Order of the Day for the next sitting.
 5. ADJOURNMENT.—Mr. Fenton (Acting Prime Minister) moved, That the House do now adjourn.
Debate ensued.
Question—put and passed.
- And then the House, at ten minutes to four o'clock p.m., adjourned until Wednesday next at three o'clock p.m.
