1. The House met, at half-past ten o'clock a.m., pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker (the Honorable G. H. Mackay) took the Chair, and read Prayers.
 2. PAPERS.—Mr. Speaker presented, pursuant to Statute—
Audit Act—Finance 1930-31—Treasurer's Statement of Receipts and Expenditure for year ended 30th June, 1931, accompanied by the Report of the Auditor-General.
Ordered to be printed.
The following Paper was presented, by command of His Excellency the Governor-General—
Norfolk Island—Report for year ended 30th June, 1931.
Ordered to lie on the Table.
 3. SUPPLY.—Mr. Lyons (Prime Minister), in accordance with Standing Order No. 240, moved, That the House will, at the next sitting, resolve itself into a Committee to consider the Supply to be granted to His Majesty.
Question—put and passed.
 4. WAYS AND MEANS.—Mr. Lyons (Prime Minister), in accordance with Standing Order No. 240, moved, That the House will, at the next sitting, resolve itself into a Committee to consider the Ways and Means for raising the Supply to be granted to His Majesty.
Question—put and passed.
 5. FINANCIAL AGREEMENT ENFORCEMENT BILL.—The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question, That the Bill be now read a second time—
Debate resumed.
Mr. Latham (Attorney-General) not having concluded his speech at the termination of the time allowed by Standing Order No. 257B—
Ordered—That the honorable Member have leave to continue his speech.
Mr. Scullin moved, That the debate be now adjourned.
Question—That the debate be now adjourned—put and passed.
Ordered—That the resumption of the debate be made an Order of the Day for the next sitting.
 6. ADJOURNMENT.—Mr. Lyons (Prime Minister) moved, That the House do now adjourn.
Debate ensued.
Question—put and passed.
