(1) That the Schedule to the *Customs Tariff* 1921-1930 be amended as hereunder set out, and that on and after the fourth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirtytwo, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Territory for the Seat of Government, Duties of Customs be collected in pursuance of the *Customs Tariff* 1921-1930 as so amended (in lieu of the duties specified in Tariff Proposals).

That in this Resolution "Tariff Proposals" means the Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the following dates, namely :---

25th February, 1932 (other than Proposals imposing Special Duty

of Customs and Primage Duty); and

17th March, 1932.

That the Duties of Customs hereunder set out shall be deemed to be an amendment of the Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the 25th February, 1932, within the meaning of the second paragraph of the Resolution introduced into the House of Representatives on the 25th February, 1932, imposing a Special Duty of Customs.

That, excepting by mutual agreement or until after six months' notice has been given to the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, nothing in this Resolution shall affect any goods the produce or manufacture of the Dominion of New Zealand entering the Commonwealth of Australia from the Dominion of New Zealand.

(2) That the Schedule to the *Customs Tariff* 1921-1930 be amended as hereunder set out, and that on and after the fourth day of May, One thousand nine hundred and thirtytwo, at nine o'clock in the forenoon, reckoned according to standard time in the Territory for the Seat of Government, Duties of Customs be collected in pursuance of the *Customs Tariff* 1921-1930 as so amended (in lieu of the duties specified in Tariff Proposals).

That in this Resolution "Tariff Proposals" means the Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the following dates, namely :---

25th February, 1932 (other than Proposals imposing Special Duty of Customs and Primage Duty); and

17th March, 1932.

That the Duties of Customs hereunder set out shall be deemed to be an amendment of the Customs Tariff Proposals introduced into the House of Representatives on the 25th February, 1932, within the meaning of the second paragraph of the Resolution introduced into the House of Representatives on the 25th February, 1932, imposing a Special Duty of Customs.
