1. The House met, at half-past ten o'clock a.m., pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker (the Honorable A. G. Cameron) took the Chair, and read Prayers.
2. DEATH OF MEMBER (THE HONORABLE H. P. LAZZARINI).—Mr. Menzies (Prime Minister) announced, with profound regret, the death yesterday of the Honorable H. P. Lazzarini, and moved, That this House expresses its deep regret at the death of the Honorable Hubert Peter Lazzarini, who at the time of his death was Member for the Division of Werriwa in this House, places on record its appreciation of his meritorious public service and tenders its profound sympathy to his family in their bereavement.
And Mr. Evatt (Leader of the Opposition) having seconded the motion, and Sir Arthur Fadden (Treasurer) having addressed the House in support thereof, and all Members present having risen, in silence—
Question—passed.
3. ALTERATION OF DAY OF NEXT MEETING.—Mr. Menzies (Prime Minister) moved, That the House, at its rising, adjourn until Tuesday next at half-past two o'clock p.m.
Question—put and passed.
4. ADJOURNMENT AS MARK OF RESPECT.—Mr. Menzies (Prime Minister) then moved, as a mark of respect to the memory of the deceased Member, That the House do now adjourn.
Question—put and passed.

And then the House, at eighteen minutes to eleven o'clock a.m., adjourned until Tuesday next at half-past two o'clock p.m.
