1. The House met, at half-past eleven o'clock a.m., pursuant to adjournment.—The Deputy Speaker (Mr. Bowden) took the Chair, and read Prayers.
2. COMMONWEALTH PARLIAMENTARY ASSOCIATION VISITORS.—Mr. Speaker drew the attention of the House to the presence in the galleries of a large number of distinguished visitors who had come from many countries within the Commonwealth of Nations to represent their Branches at the Commonwealth Parliamentary Conference to be held in this Chamber next week. On behalf of the House, Mr. Speaker welcomed the visitors and wished them well in their discussion at the Conference.
3. PAPERS.—The following Papers were presented, pursuant to Statute—
 International Monetary Agreements Act—Annual Report on operations of the Act, and in so far as they relate to Australia, of the International Monetary Fund Agreement and the International Bank Agreement, for year 1958-59.
 Public Service Act—Appointment—Department of Territories—J. A. Dorling.
 Seat of Government (Administration) Act—Ordinance—1959—No. 13—Stock Diseases.
