1. The House met, at half-past two o'clock p.m., pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker (the Honorable Sir John McLeay) took the Chair, and read Prayers.
2. QUESTIONS.—Questions without notice were answered.
3. NORTHERN TERRITORY (ADMINISTRATION) BILL 1962.—Mr. Hasluck (Minister for Territories) moved, pursuant to notice, That he have leave to bring in a Bill for an Act relating to the Powers, Privileges and Immunities of the Legislative Council for the Northern Territory.
Question—put and passed.
Bill brought up, and read a first time.
Mr. Hasluck moved, by leave, That the Bill be now read a second time.
Debate adjourned (Mr. Whitlam), and the resumption of the debate made an Order of the Day for the next sitting.
4. DAIRYING INDUSTRY BILL 1962.—The Order of the Day having been read for the resumption of the debate on the question, That the Bill be now read a second time—
Debate resumed.
Debate adjourned (Mr. Kelly), and the resumption of the debate made an Order of the Day for the next sitting.
5. ADJOURNMENT.—Mr. Adermann (Minister for Primary Industry) moved, That the House do now adjourn.
Debate ensued.
