### WEDNESDAY, 7TH AUGUST, 1912.

- 1. The House met, at half-past two o'clock p.m., pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker took the Chair, and read Prayers.
- 2. Leave of Absence to Member (Mr. Hans Irvine).—Mr. R. W. Foster moved, by leave, That leave of absence for two months be given to the honorable Member for Grampians (Mr. Hans Irvine) on account of absence from the Commonwealth.
