## VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

## HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES.

TUESDAY, 25TH NOVEMBER, 1913.

1. The House met, at three o'clock p.m., pursuant to adjournment.—Mr. Speaker took the Chair, and read Prayers.
2. DEATH OF MEMBER (THE HONORABLE C. E. FRAZER).—Mr. Joseph Cook having announced, with deep regret, the death, this day, of the honorable Member for Kalgoorlie (the Honorable Charles Edward Frazer), moved, by leave—  
That this House places upon record its high appreciation of the great public services of the late Member for Kalgoorlie, the Honorable C. E. Frazer, and tenders its sincere sympathy to the bereaved widow of an eminent citizen whose untimely decease is a great loss to the Commonwealth.  
And Mr. Fisher having seconded the motion, and all Members present having risen in silence—  
Question—passed.  
Resolved—That Mr. Speaker be requested to transmit the foregoing Resolution, and a copy of the addresses delivered thereon, to Mrs. Frazer.
3. ADJOURNMENT.—Mr. Joseph Cook, as a mark of respect to the memory of the late honorable Member, then moved, That the House do now adjourn.  
Question—put and passed.

And then the House, at fourteen minutes past three o'clock, p.m., adjourned until to-morrow at half-past two o'clock p.m.
