Message No. 83.

A Bill intituled "An Act to amend the 'Land Tax Act 1910-1914'," as finally passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Commonwealth, having been presented to the Governor-General for the Royal Assent, His Excellency has, in the name and on behalf of His Majesty, assented to the said Act.
