South Australian Elections 1989

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Introduction

This Paper contains an analysis of voting in the South Australian House of Assembly and Legislative Council elections held on 25 November 1989. Voting figures used in this Paper are taken from information supplied by the South Australian State Electoral Department

Percentage figures shown against a party or candidate represent the party or candidate's votes as a percentage of formal votes. Percentages against formal and informal votes represent formal and informal votes as a percentage of total votes. Percentages against total votes represent total votes as a percentage of electors enrolled.

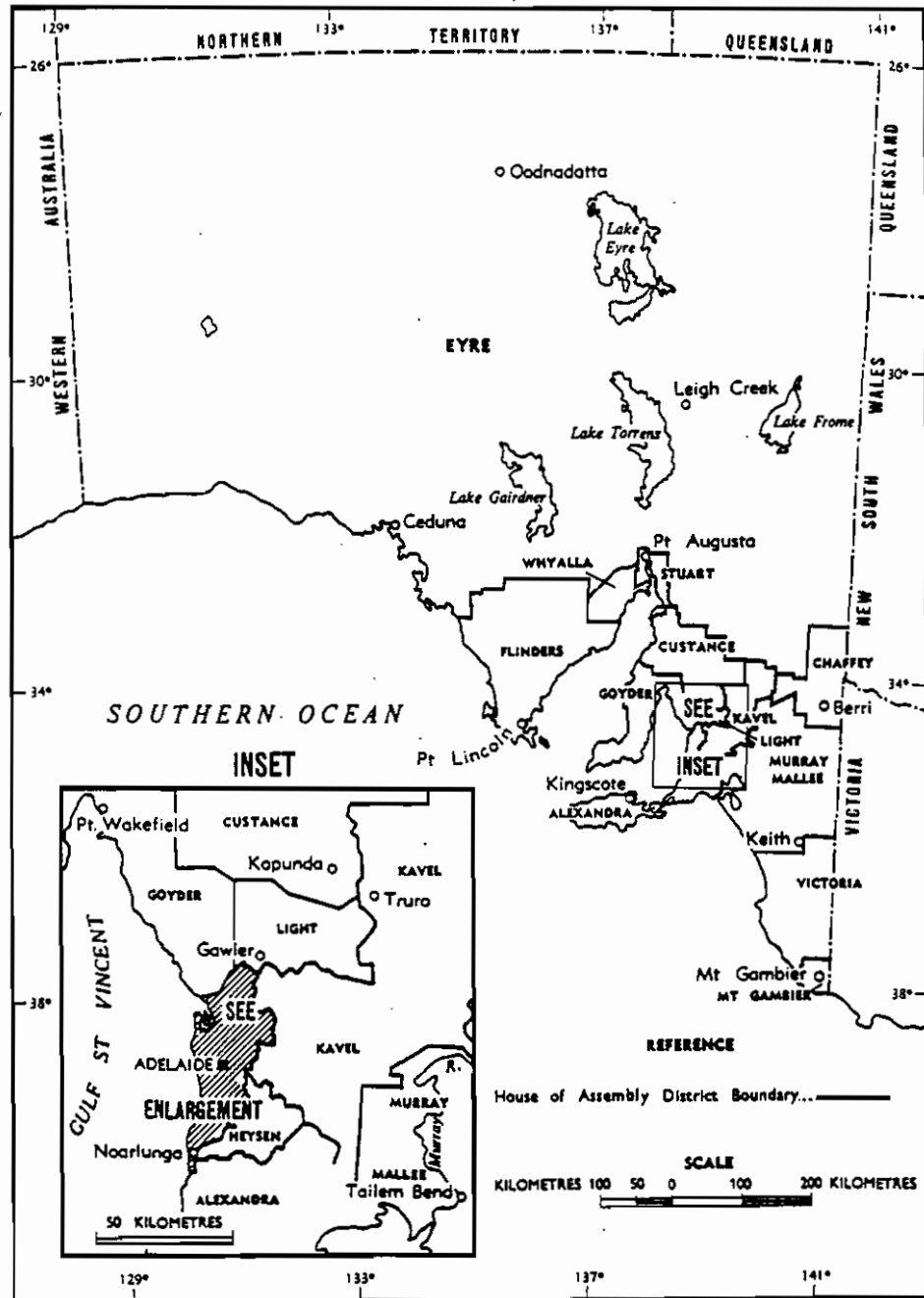

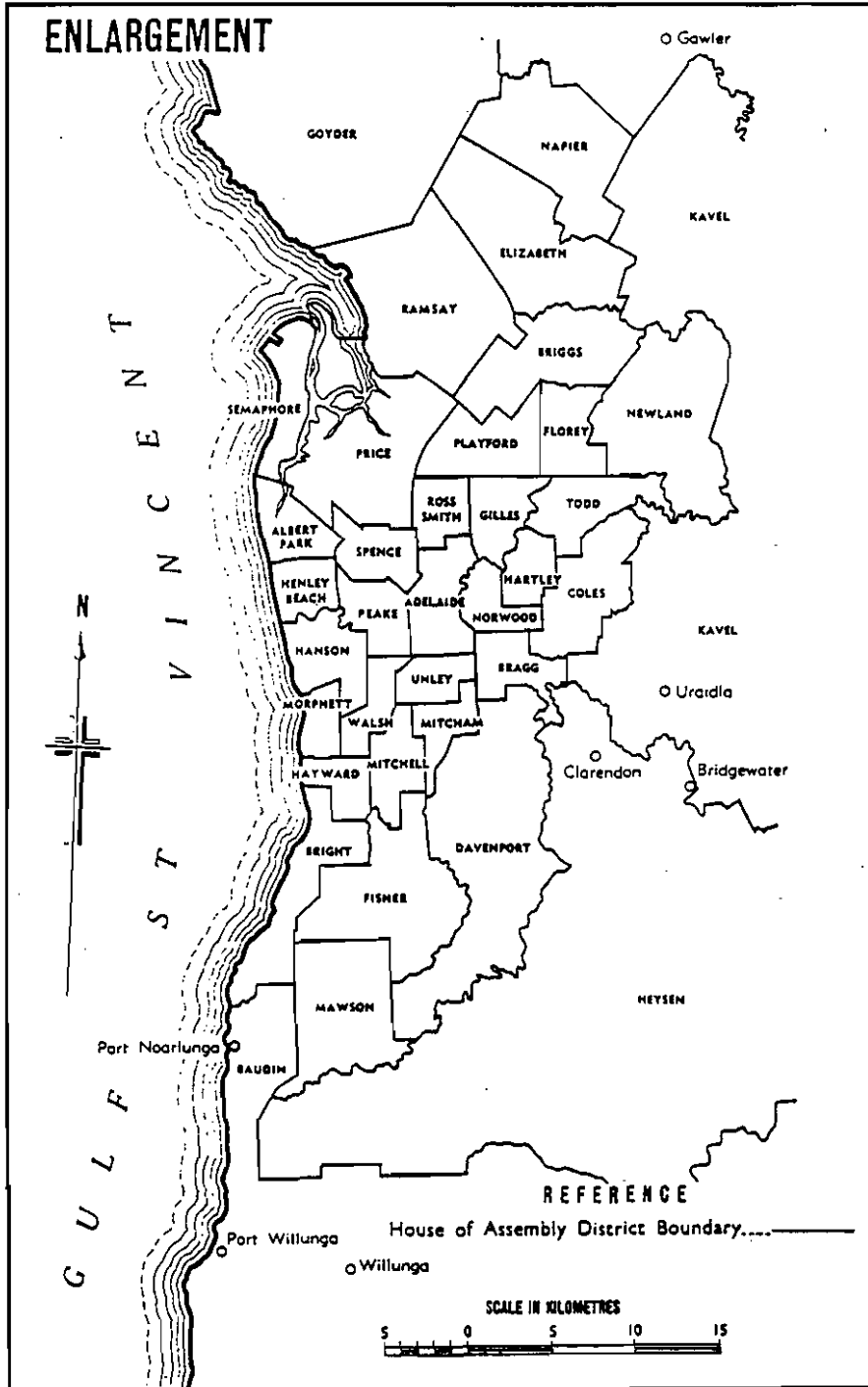
