## Customs Tariff Proposal No. 6 (2003)

### Motion to be moved by Mr Slipper (Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Finance and Administration) on 16 October 2003

1. That the *Customs Tariff Act 1995*, as proposed to be altered by Customs Tariff Proposals, be further altered as set out in the Schedule to this Proposal and that the further alteration operates on and from 18 October 2003.
