Under <u>Senate standing order 55</u> the President has recalled the Senate at the request of an absolute majority of senators. The next meeting of the Senate will now take place on Friday 7 November 2003 at 9.00am. The Senate will consider the Criminal Code Amendment (Hamas and Lashkar-e-Tayyiba) Bill 2003. The Senate is then scheduled to meet from 24 November to 4 December 2003.
