**Parliament Drive – resurfacing works – minor deferral**

1        On Thursday 11 February we sent an Information Circular to building occupants about the plans to complete the resurfacing of Parliament Drive. The program of final works was to commence on Monday 15 February, weather permitting.

2        The weekend rains have been very welcome for Canberra, but the rains have extended into Monday. This further rain has obliged us to defer the actual resurfacing.

3        The weather outlook for tomorrow (Tuesday 16 February) is for fine weather, and accordingly we now plan to commence the resurfacing work early tomorrow morning.

4        The initial work on Tuesday 16 February will focus on the intersection of Melbourne Avenue and Parliament Drive; this work should be complete by mid-morning. The works to the north of Parliament House will begin at the Kings Avenue intersection at approximately 8 am. Detours signs will be in place to direct traffic to or away from the precinct. Works are planned to be complete by Tuesday evening, but possibly may extend into Wednesday 17 February.

5        Apart from the change of dates, other details of the resurfacing activity are the same as outlined in Information Circular No. 2010/3, dated 11 February. Importantly, traffic controllers will be directing motorists during the resurfacing period.

6        ACTION buses advises: "Due to the roadwork on Parliament Drive, the bus stops at Parliament House will not be serviced by routes 2 and 3 on Monday 15 and Tuesday 16 February. The nearest stops are located on Melbourne Avenue or Brisbane Avenue." See <http://www.action.act.gov.au/default.html> for further information on bus routes.
