

## Temporary closure of access from the Marble Foyer to the Senate (Security Point 2) 26 March-17 April 2011

- The doors controlling access to the Senate from the Marble Foyer (Security Point 2, which is next to Aussies) are scheduled to be upgraded over the Easter recess.
- To allow sufficient time for the new electronic doors to be installed and tested, this access point will close at midnight on Friday 25 March 2011. Normal operations are expected to resume at midnight on Sunday 17 April 2011.
- During the installation period, the north-west link way security point on the first floor (adjacent to Magna Carta) will be open as an alternative access point to the private areas on the western (Senate) side. The hours of operation of the link way access point will be 9.00am to 5.00pm each day, the same as Security Point 2. Attached is a showing the location of both access points.
