Temporary closure of access from the Marble Foyer to the House of Representatives (Security Point 3) 7-23 January 2011

1 The doors controlling access to the House of Representatives from the Marble Foyer (Security Point 3) are scheduled to be upgraded over the summer recess.

2 To allow sufficient time for the new electronic doors to be installed and tested, this access point will close at 11.00pm on Friday 7 January 2011. Normal operations are expected to resume at 11.00pm on Sunday 23 January 2011.


3 During the installation period, the north link way security point (adjacent to Australia Post) on the first floor will be open as an alternative access point to the private areas on the eastern (House of Representatives) side. The hours of operation of the link way access point will be 9.00am to 5.00pm each day, the same as Security Point 3. Attached is a map showing the location of both access points.

4 The doors controlling access to the Senate from the Marble Foyer (adjacent to Aussies) will be upgraded at a later date. An information circular will be released prior to this occurring.
